Dear Residents and Families:

This letter is to update you on the positive COVID-19 cases in our facility, as well as continuing to update you on the steps we are taking to keep you and your loved ones safe. At this time there are NO new positive cases of COVID-19 among residents or staff. Our facility is in communication with the Arkansas Department of Health and following facility protocols to ensure the safety of staff and residents. We will continue to post updates every Monday, unless we have a staff member or resident test positive. In those instances, we will update our website by 5 PM the following day.

We do want to Inform you that we have had 4 residents with upper respiratory symptoms on 9/13/2020. We are taking additional precautions to quarantine all residents on that hall, out of an abundance of precaution, until the diagnostic test results are back. If there is a positive case of COVID-19, we will post an update.

Below are actions the facility continues to take, to stop any spread of the virus and changes to normal facility operations:

- We continue to educate our staff and residents about COVID-19, as well as the importance of handwashing and good cough hygiene.
- We continue to follow staff and resident screening and testing requirements issued by federal and state authorities.
- We are electronically tracking PPE inventory levels daily.
- We are ensuring that residents have the tools they need to wash hands.
- We are screening all new admissions to the facility.
- We have restricted visitors, except for extreme circumstances.
- We are encouraging our residents to cover their mouths when receiving care.

Please continue to schedule Facetime visitation with your loved one. They would love to be able to connect with you and we have times and dates available. Please feel free to call your administrator if you have any questions, concerns or ideas. We are spending all day, every day, working to keep you and your family safe.
